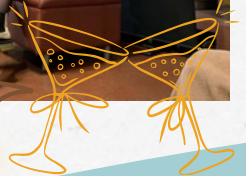
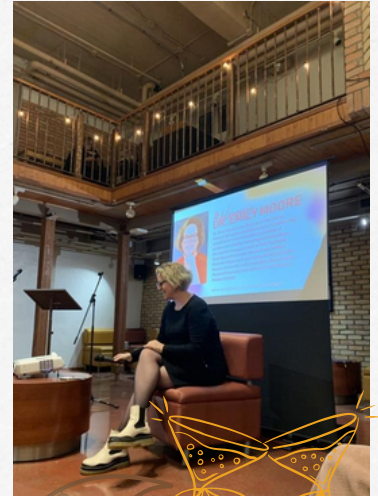




CHEERS TO ALUMNI

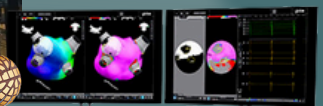
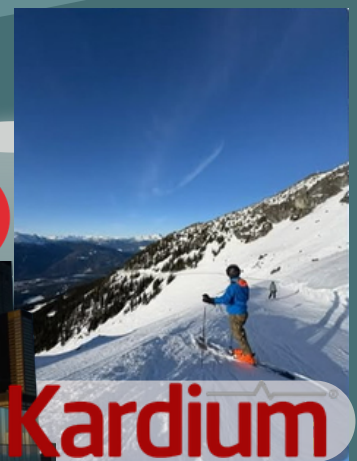


FEBRUARY SPOTLIGHT

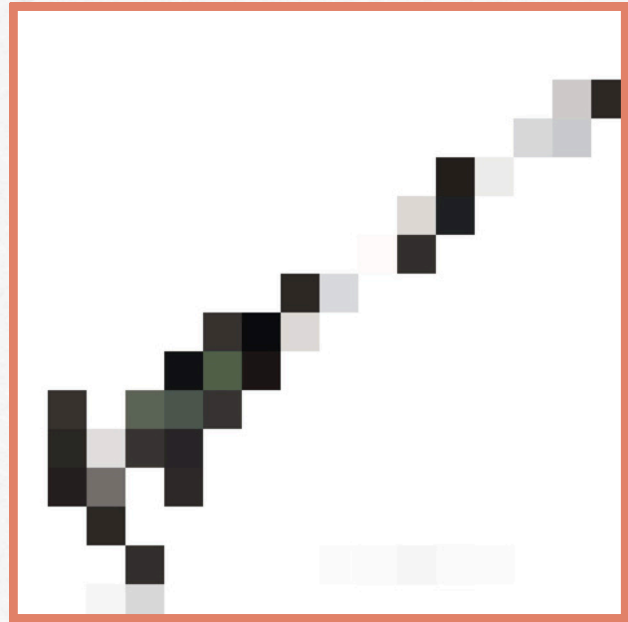
