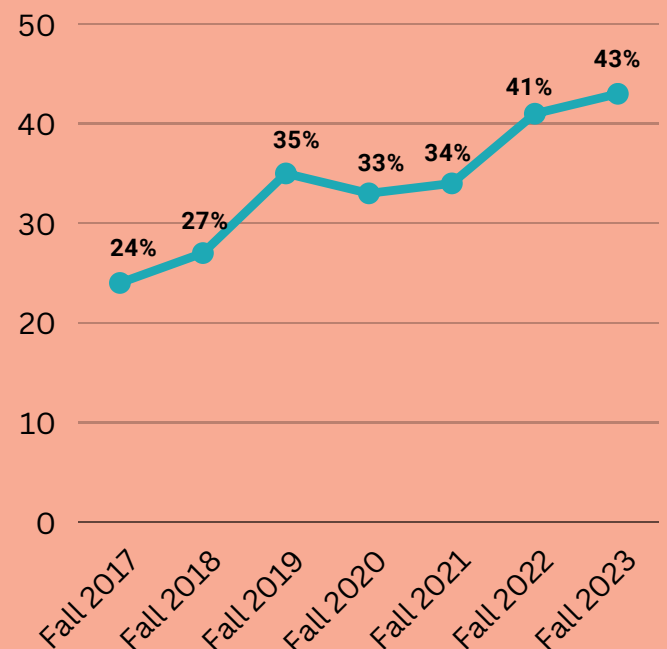
43% OF MCMASTER'S INCOMING BEng UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS ARE WOMEN !

INCOMING WOMEN ENGINEERS, as % of Total





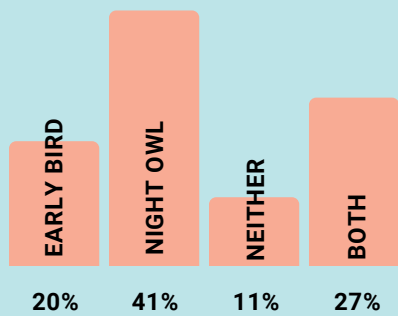

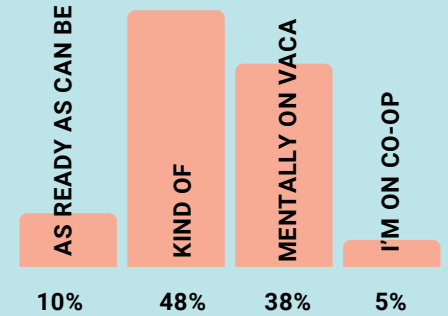
