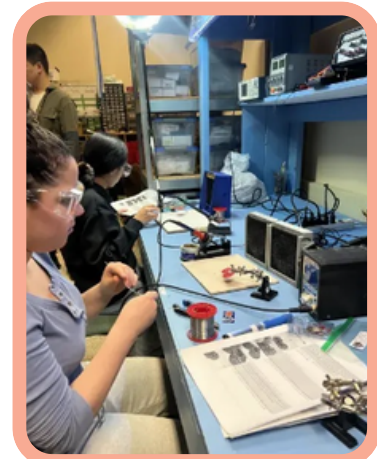

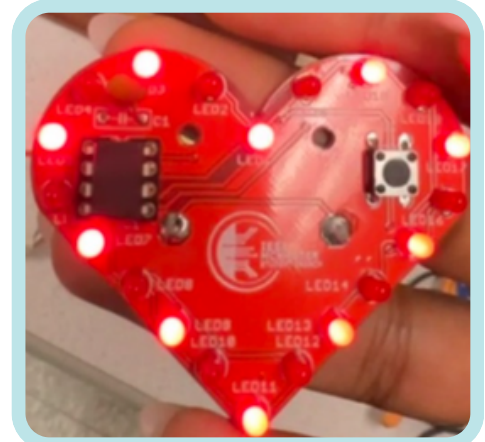
### SOLDERING HEARTS

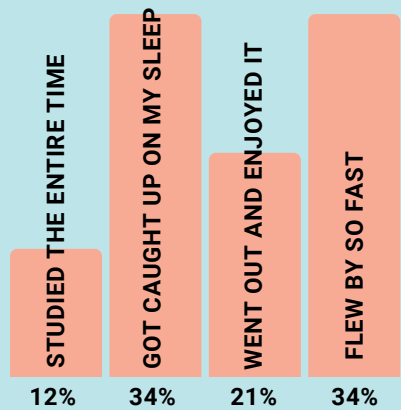

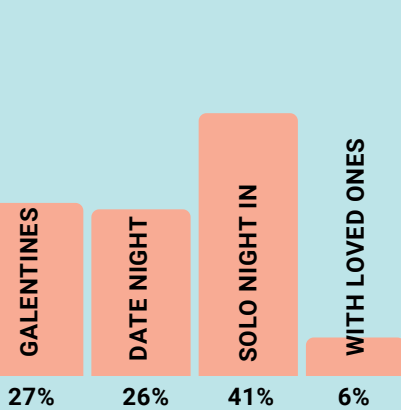

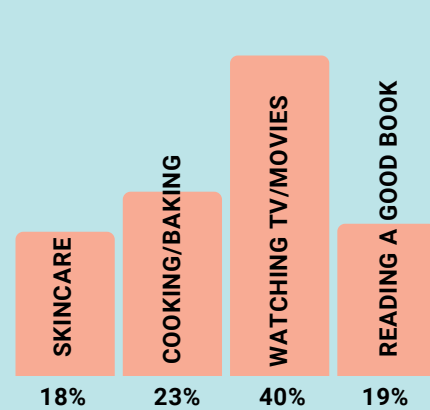
